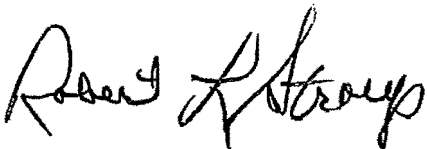
district. Brother Stewart, we all owe you a debt of gratitude. Thank you from the Indiana District!
